

SAME SONG, DIFFERENT VERSE

It certainly seems that sounding an alarm to American Christians is an exercise in futility. Some get angry and even those who nod in agreement do little or nothing to stem the coming threat to our liberty. Islam threatens the world with domination. Islam has no intention of peaceful coexistence with freedom of speech or any other civil or religious liberty the free world has and continues to enjoy.

The fact that surveys show any society with a household birthrate below 2.1 cannot sustain itself. Any society with a birthrate lower than 1.3 has zero chance of survival.
